Jewish Family Service



- Serving San Diego since 1918
- More than 50 programs throughout San Diego County and parts of Riverside County
- "One Source for a Lifetime of Help"
- Service to everyone, regardless of religion









- Jewish Family Service's Positive Parenting Program is a County of San Diego funded Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) program.
- Using the evidence-based Triple P America model, JFS assists parents/caregivers/families, educators and child care providers the following settings:
 - Head Start and Early Head Start Centers
 - Sites dedicated to serving military families
 - Community locations throughout the County
 - Low-Income Elementary Schools









Program Demographics

- We serve all areas of the County
- Services are available in English and Spanish
- Prevention curriculum is available at Community and School sites
- Early Intervention curriculum is provided at Head Start and Military locations (along with the Prevention curriculum)

Eligibility

- For Prevention: no eligibility criteria, the program is available to all San Diego County parents
- For Early Intervention: must be a Head Start parent (child currently enrolled) or a family impacted by a parent or caregivers Military service









Prevention

SEMINAR SERIES

(LARGER GROUPS)

3 Sessions (Approx. 2 hrs each)

- (1) The Power of Positive Parenting
- (2) Raising Confident, Competent Children
- (3) Raising Resilient Children





(ONE-ON-ONE WORK)

4 Sessions (Approx. 30 mins. each)

In-depth problem solving for 1 or 2 specific behavior difficulties. Allows for individualized parent plan for managing challenging behavior.



GROUP

(SMALLER GROUPS)

8 Sessions (5, 2 hour groups and 3 shorter individual meetings)

Focus is on more complex behavior difficulties. Group format normalizes parenting challenges and builds social network with other parents.

Early Intervention









What we provide:

- Trained Educators
- Healthy Snacks and Child Activities during the sessions
- Incentives and Prizes during Seminars and Groups
- Tip Sheets, Specialized Parenting Materials and opportunities to view Triple P videos
- Connections to other programs when a family needs additional help

Outcome highlights (FY 10-11):

- 1,157 unique families served, 79% were Latino/Hispanic
- 99% of parents evaluated reflected improvement in their parenting skills
- 95% of parents participating in the Group component had a reduction in Depression, Anxiety and Stress levels
