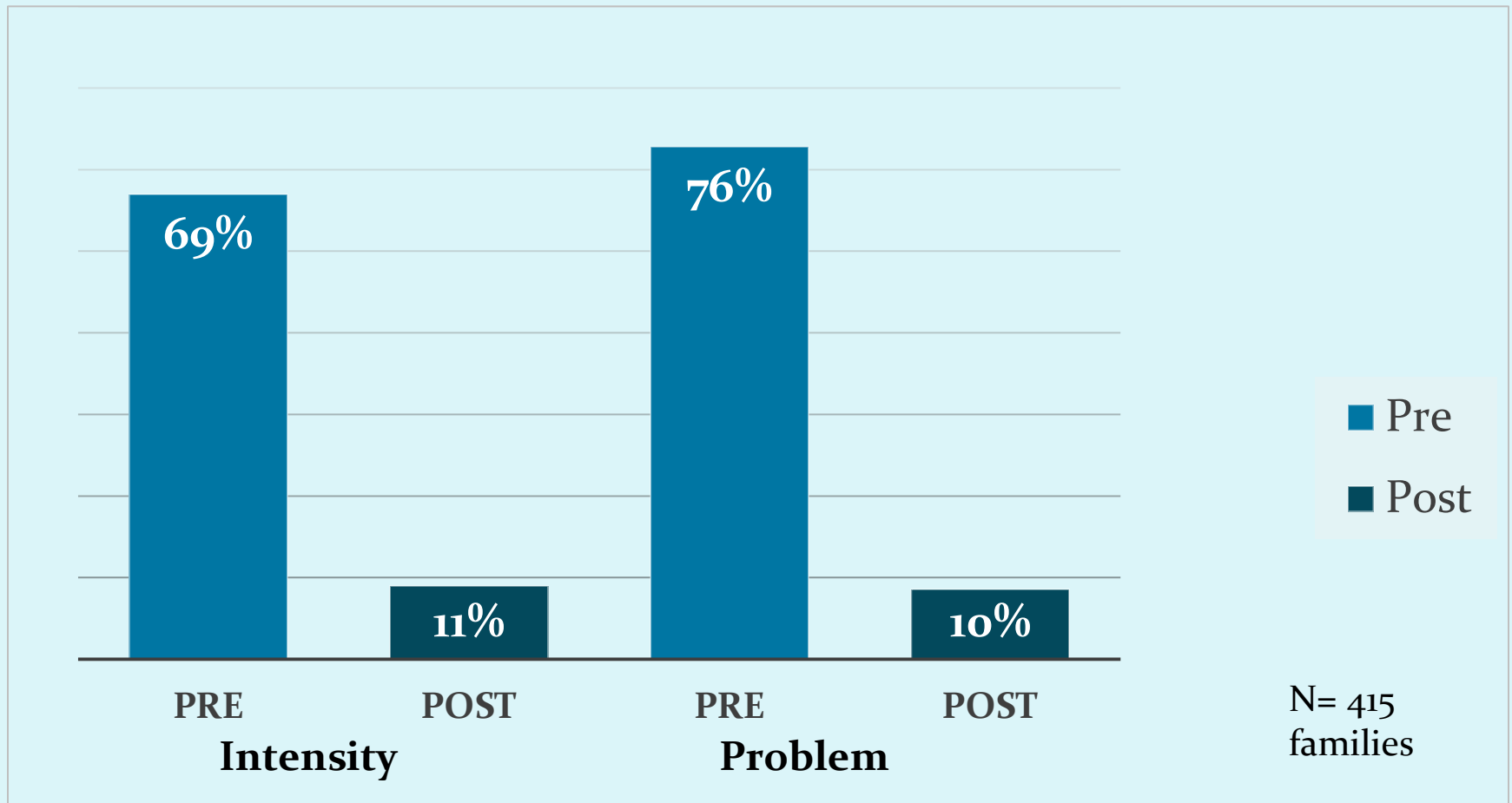

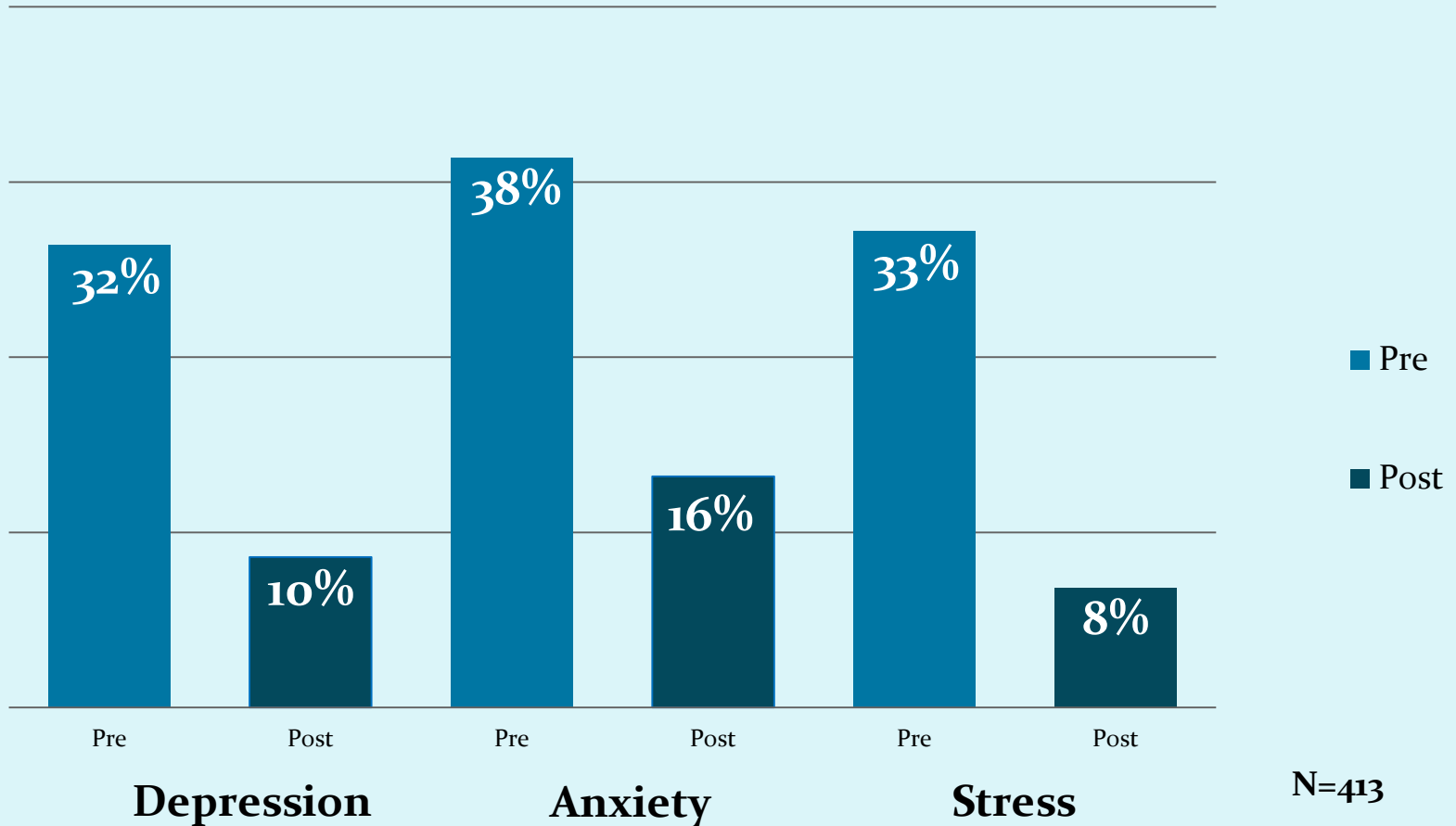

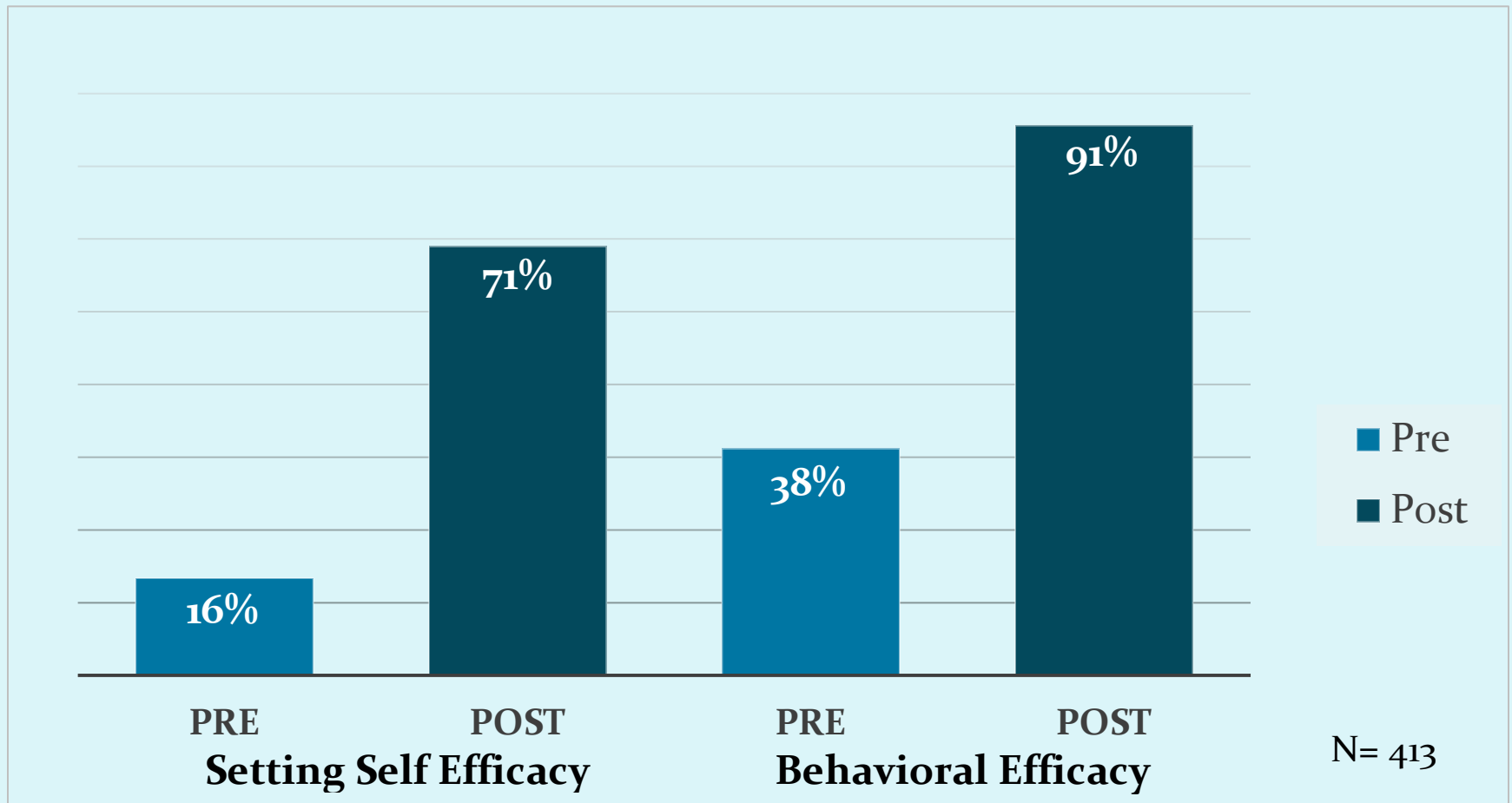
ECBI Results (Level 4)
