
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

- Funded by 4 child-serving agencies
- Purpose: To help nonprofit and civil service agencies deliver and sustain evidence-based parenting interventions
 - Previous efforts used the "train and pray" model
- Triple P delivered in English, Spanish & Chinese languages








Triple P Outcomes

Parent-report measures are administered at pretest, posttest, 3 month, 6 month, and 1 year follow up in the parent's preferred language (English, Spanish, Chinese)

Domains / Measures


- Parenting Practices (Parenting Scale)
- Child Behavior (Eyberg Child Behavior Inventory ECBI)
- Parental Stress (Depression, Anxiety Stress Scale DASS21)
- Service Needs (PTI-developed measure)




Triple P Child Behavior Outcomes Over Time

The following 2 slides show Triple P 12-month ECBI outcomes for prevention and intervention cohorts:


- Prevention: Caregivers who scored under the clinical cutoff (84th percentile) at pretest
- Intervention: Caregivers who scored over the clinical cutoff (84th percentile) at pretest



Number of Child Behavior Problems




Frequency of Problems



Triple P Parenting Outcomes Over Time

The following 4 slides show Triple P 12-month Parenting Scale outcomes for prevention and intervention cohorts:


- Prevention: Caregivers with a raw score under 3.1 (on a scale of 1 to 7) at pretest
- Intervention: Caregivers with a raw score of 3.1 of higher (on a scale of 1 to 7) at pretest



Parenting Scale Total Score




